

Community

The Eastern Lebanon County School District is located in the southeastern part of Lebanon County and serves the residents of a largely rural geographic locale. The District includes two boroughs and three townships with a population of 15,500 residents. A few large industries, many small businesses and numerous family farming operations characterize local economy.

School

Eastern Lebanon County High School is a comprehensive, four year high school with a total enrollment of 814 students. Four elementary schools and a 6-8 grade middle school also serve the community. The total student enrollment is 2,580. Approximately 40% of ELCO graduates pursue a four-year college study and 29% pursue other formal education beyond high school. The teacher/student ratio is 11:1. Class periods are scheduled for 80 minutes in a 4-day cycle. Students take 4 classes each semester and educational progress is assessed in 9-week grading periods.

Special Curriculum Features

The honors courses identified in our transcript represent our school's enriched and accelerated courses. They have been specifically designed to be appropriate for and to challenge those students in our school's gifted program; however, the courses are also open to other high-achieving students.

Advanced Placement courses are offered in English, American history, European History, calculus, biology and environmental science. To those who qualify, college-level study is available through Harrisburg Area Community College and Lebanon Valley College.

Class Rank is a measure of the academic achievement of any one student in a class in relationship to all other students in the class. It is based upon a weighted grade point average, cumulative to include all semesters and all classes except physical education, band, and chorus. Cumulative **non-weighted GPA** and **weighted class rank** are computed at the close of each school year. School transcripts identify both weighted and unweighted GPA, as well as weighted class rank.

College Prep classes include all College Prep English and history, math and science, foreign languages, computer programming, and other elected elective courses. The honors category includes all classes specifically labeled as honors, as well as physics, anatomy, and 3rd & 4th year foreign language classes.

Weighted grading is used for class rank, and is based on the chart below:

Graduations requirements: *Twenty-eight (28) units of credit plus a graduation project in grade 12 are required for graduation of all students. The requirements include four (4) units of English, four (4) units of social studies, four (4) units of mathematics, four (4) units of science, three (3) unit of health and physical education, four (4) units of arts and/or humanities, and five(5) units in approved elective courses.*
