By meeting the following classroom expectations, each student will succeed in this academic setting. 1. **Behavior:**

All students will respect the rights and opinions of fellow classmates. All students will be respectful and courteous to one another and follow school regulations. Disrespect toward another student or any adult will not be tolerated.

2. **Attendance:**

All students are expected to attend class on a daily basis. Students need to report to class on time. In event of an absence, **the student** is responsible to contact me about any missed assignments. Poor attendance will affect a student's learning and academic progress.

3. **Educational Materials:**

All students are responsible for the proper care of their textbook, computer equipment, and any other classroom or library materials. All students **must** keep a class notebook.

4. **Classroom Participation:**

All students are required to take an **active** role in this learning experience. Students will be required to participate in class discussions, group learning experiences and oral presentations. Completing homework assignments and assigned readings are essential to classroom participation and academic success.

5. **Classroom Rules:**

All students will follow these rules.

1. Be on time for class.
2. Be prepared for class.
3. Be polite and courteous to all.
4. Strive to achieve your personal best.

6. Grading Procedures:

Grades in this class are based on a point value system. The marking period grade will be comprised of quiz scores, chapter and unit tests, class participation, class preparedness, oral presentations, group work, the class notebook, and a variety of homework. A research assignment and book report may be required along with other unit projects. Students may check their academic progress at any time. Parents may access their student's detailed grade information using the school provided password for PowerGrade. Any questions regarding the PowerGrade system can be directed to the ELCO High School office.

Daily homework assignments **will not** be accepted late. Students will receive a zero for any late work. However, projects and long-term assignments will be graded as follows:

1. Turned in after scheduled class meeting = 10% reduction of corrected grade
2. 1 day late = 25% reduction of corrected grade
3. 2 days late = 50% reduction of corrected grade
4. Beyond 2 days late = no credit for the assignment will be given

Students who are legally absent from school will be given the appropriate make-up time according to school regulations.
