

## Pottery Classroom Expectations and Rules

1. BE ON TIME. If you are late you must have a late pass to enter class. Go to designated seat and wait for daily directions. BE PREPARED. When getting materials and tools, do so in an orderly manner.
2. RESPECT yourself, the instructor, and peers' rights.
3. When using tools, materials, paper, glazes, etc. ask before taking items from the closet. Materials are expensive. Use, not abuse, them.
4. Students are expected to be present for all instructor demonstrations. If you are absent from class you are responsible for missed work. Please make arrangements with the instructor for make up work.
5. You will not be allowed to leave the classroom. Come prepared.
6. LISTEN and follow directions the first time. If I have to stop and repeat instructions we both lose valuable time to work and be creative. (WHEN INSTRUCTOR IS SPEAKING YOU ARE NOT).
7. Use appropriate language at all times. (Swearing and foul language is unacceptable.)
8. CLEAN UP at the end of each class period and return all materials to proper storage areas. Brush off tables. Sponge off tables. Clean brushes. All students will have an assigned area that they will be responsible for throughout the marking period

### GRADES.....

Grades are determined by: daily participation (Students will be graded on a daily basis. Daily participation is imperative. Grades are 65-59=A, 58-52=B, 51-45=C, 49=C+ etc. All completed assignments and pieces are graded. The following may be taken into consideration: technique, craftsmanship, rendering, creativity, composition, overall design, student followed assignment directions, etc.
