

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS
U.S. CULTURES - MR. MILLER

Students will treat everybody in the classroom with respect. There are NO exceptions.

Students will come prepared for class everyday. They will have their book, a notebook and a pen or pencil on their desk. Books MUST be covered with a non-adhesive or spandex cover. Being frequently unprepared will lower your grade. The notebook kept by students must be kept organized and in chronological order.

Students will not be issued passes to lockers. No period E passes will be handed out, students must come to a period E with a pass in hand!

Students will contribute to class in a positive manner. Raise your hand and wait silently until you are acknowledged if you have a question or a comment. Do not interrupt others.

Students must be in their assigned seat when the bell rings. Three warnings will be issued. Any subsequent tardiness will result in a detention.

Homework is to be completed on time. Late homework will not be accepted. It is the students' responsibility to complete assignments on time. Late projects will only be accepted one day after the due date for 80% credit. Any assignment that comes in later than one day late is a zero.

If a student is absent, he or she must see Mr. Miller the first day they are back to receive the make-up assignments. Work that was assigned prior to the absence, such as homework or a test or quiz that was given the day a student was out, must be turned in or completed the FIRST DAY BACK. This is to help students, not hurt them. The longer it takes to make up a test or quiz the less information you'll retain. Exceptions will only be made in cases the teacher deems appropriate.

All students will be required to maintain a personal folder for all quizzes, tests and other specified assignments. This folder will be checked throughout the year and turned in prior to the final. This folder will not leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher.

Homework / Classwork - 25%

Quizzes - 20%

Projects - 15%

We will go over each of these rules in detail on the first day of class. This list is to be stored in the notebook for the rest of the semester. Failure to meet these expectations will first result in a verbal warning. Any subsequent problems will result in a phone call to the parents followed by a detention. Further infractions will result in a disciplinary referral.
