Classroom Expectations for Students

I. Behavior

Students are responsible for maintaining proper behavior which respects the rights of all individuals involved in the educational process.

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. Students are expected to be courteous and polite to all other individuals in the classroom.**
- 2. Students are expected to be working and participating in all class activities and assignments.**

II. Attendance

Students are responsible for regular school attendance, to report to their assigned classes on time, and to make up work missed due to absences.

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. If a student is absent, he or she is expected to make arrangements with the teacher to complete any missed work.**
- 2. Students are expected to complete all work missed when absent.**

III. Grading Procedures

Students are responsible for understanding the grading procedures established by their teachers. Parents may access student grade information online through Power School For Parents (<https://powerschool.elco.k12.pa.us/public>).

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. Students will be graded on class assignments, participation, homework, tests, quizzes, group work, midterm exam/project, and a final exam/project.**
- 2. Each aspect of the class will be given a certain number of points. At the end of the marking period, all of the student's points will be totaled. The student's total number of points will be divided by the total possible points. The end result will be the student's percentage grade for the marking period.**

IV. Classroom Participation

Students are responsible for participation in classroom activities and for completing assigned work.

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. Students must complete all assignments by the day they are due.**
- 2. Vocal (as well as written) participation is a vital part of each class. Students are expected to voice their questions, answers, and opinions pertaining to the subject of the class.**
- 3. Students are expected to help other students understand the course material.**

V. Classroom Rules

Students are responsible for following the specific classroom rules established by their teachers.

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. Individual communicating (talking, writing notes, etc.) will not be permitted.**
- 2. Students will be working on the assignments and class materials for the specific class they are in throughout the class period.**
- 3. Students will remain seated throughout the class until they are excused.**

VI. Educational Materials and Equipment

Students are responsible for the proper care of all the educational materials and equipment they use.

Classroom Rules/Regulations

- 1. Students are expected to take proper care of the textbook issued to them and/or any equipment they might use.**
- 2. Students must always come to class with a writing instrument, textbook, workbook and notebook/folder.**
