CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

I expect my students to:

RESPECT

- Each other, guests in class, and me your teacher.
- School property, the property of others, your own property.

BE RESPONSIBLE

- In being prepared for class. We will use our books nearly EVERY day, take notes nearly EVERY day, and need WRITING utensils EVERY day.
- In all manner of SPEECH and DRESS in and out of the classroom. If you violate the dress code, you will be sent to the office. If you choose inappropriate language you earn a school detention.

BE PRESENT

- In the classroom in both MIND and BODY. This means actively participating in class discussions AND group and individual work.
- ANY work missed due to absences or tardiness is the *full responsibility of the student* to **determine** and **complete** in the time allotted.

Grading Procedures:

1. Tests/quizzes are given periodically *with prior notice*. (Tests: 35%, Quizzes 20%)
2. Notebook quizzes are given frequently *with NO prior notice* to assess the notebook that each student is required to keep. (Notebook Quizzes: 20%)
3. Homework is due the day after it is assigned, with the only exception being an excused absence. **Second missed assignment in a row earns a detention, and a phone call home.** (Homework: 10%, Class work: 5%, Projects: 10%)
4. Grades will be posted each week in the classroom by ID #. **Parents please note that Powerschool has been made available to you to aid in keeping YOU abreast of the academic progress of your children. Please use:** <http://powerschool.elcosd.org/public/>

Classroom Consequences:

Students will be reminded of the appropriate classroom behavior once. If the behavior continues, the student will earn a teacher detention after school at my convenience and a phone call home. If the student continues to disrupt the class, he or she will earn a school detention and if warranted a conference with parent or guardian.
