





- <u>Tier 2</u>: Paraprofessional support will be provided during the ELA instructional period to provide additional support in the form of previewing and reteaching content with small groups of students.

## **2022-2023:**


• Beg-Year scores are (3rd)45.3, (4th) 42.8, & (5th) 51.8: Average of 46.6%

# Blueprint for Success: School Climate/Culture

**Annual Improvement Target:** The Intermediate School students will see a decrease of 15% in Tier 2 disciplinary referrals that require office consequences by the end of the school year.

### **Action Plan:**

- <u>Tier 1</u>: As a preventative measure, classroom teachers will teach essential behavior standards in every classroom as part of our Tier 1 MTSS program. Students needing additional reteaching opportunities and supports will receive Tier 2 help to relearn and demonstrate our behavior standards.
- <u>Tier 2</u>: Students needing additional resources will qualify under our additional MTSS support pan in Tier 3. The students are provide frequent intense interventions based on the behavior's function and give support for essential behavior standards.

## Blueprint for Success: School Climate/Culture

#### 2022-2023

- <u>Tier 1 Incidents</u>: The Intermediate School had 286 incidents that required office attention.
- <u>Tier 2 Incidents</u>: The Intermediate School had 108 incidents that required PowerSchool documentation and disciplinary action.
- <u>Tier 3 Incidents</u>: The Intermediate School had 8 incidents that required Behavior plans.
