Data Analysis Summary

ELCO Middle School utilizes LinkIt! Testing to project and inform interventions for student learning.

<u>Math-</u> 22-23 LinkIt! Data showed 9.8% of student scoring proficient or advanced on Form C.

<u>ELA-</u> 22-23 LinkIt! Data showed 32.77% of students scoring proficient or advanced on Form C.

<u>Attendance-</u> Average attendance was at 81.5% in the 22-23 school year.

Blueprint for Success: Mathematics

<u>Improvement Target</u>: Show a 5% increase of advanced and proficient students from form A to form C of the LinkIt! Assessment by grade level co-hort.

- Action Plan: Tier 1
 - 54 minutes of daily instruction (core block)
 - Full fidelity of Spring Math intervention program
 - Individual skill practice through IXL
 - Consistent instruction across grade level
- Action Plan Tier 2
 - Small group intervention based on data team meetings
 - Math literacy practice (stations in class)
 - Reteaching in the Enrichment period



Blueprint for Success: English Language Arts

<u>Improvement Target</u>: Show a 5% increase of advanced and proficient students from form A to form C of the LinkIt! Assessment by grade level co-hort.

- Action Plan: Tier 1
 - 54 minutes of core instruction
 - Text dependent analysis prompt practice (annotate, complete, grade)
 - Individual skills practice through IXL
 - Acadience benchmarking (on grade level literacy approach)
 - Cross curricular comprehension focus with Social Studies
- Action Plan: Tier 2
 - Structured reteaching during Enrichment period
 - Data team meetings to identify additional practice groups
 - Additional intervention within the class period (small group rotation)



Blueprint for Success: School Climate/Culture

<u>Improvement Target</u>: Increase the regular daily attendance percentage from 81.5% to 85.5%

- Decrease number of habitually truant students
- Action Plan Tier 1
 - Teaming in year 2, additional parent communication and attendance interventions
 - Academic and behavior recognition of students
 - Monthly by Team
 - Quarterly as a whole school
 - Club Structure
- Action Plan Tier 2
 - Increase SAIP conferences
 - Counselors targeted intervention
 - Increased communication of absences
 - Referral process for related services (SAP, counseling, etc.)



Blueprint for Success: Community Engagement

<u>Improvement Target</u>: Create two additional opportunities for community engagement while increasing attendance at existing events.

- Action Plan Tier 1:
 - Continuation of Family Engagement Group
 - Mass communication of events, calendar of events
 - Social media presence
 - Incorporate family education programs
- Action Plan Tier 2:
 - Involve more student organizations in participation
 - Partner with K-12 groups to participate in other events
 - Creation of subcommittees for future planning



Points of Pride

Exciting Developments at the Middle School

- Year two of teaming has created consistency for student support
- Increase in the number of student organizations
- Clubs return to the middle school
- Teacher's participation in the station rotation co-hort through the IU
- Creation of the Flex period to provide individualized skillsbased practice
