

Employer Industry Tour Tips



Industry Tours are an excellent opportunity to expose students to potential careers and help them identify areas of interest. They are an invaluable part of helping students become Future Ready and we thank you for your interest!

Before the Industry Tour

- Create a checklist of items students should/should not bring to the tour
- Share pertinent information about dress code, parking, etc. with the Future Ready Facilitator
- Arrange for safety gear as necessary or communicate attire/safety requirements for the tour

During the Industry Tour

- Provide instruction in workplace safety
- Ensure that students cannot inadvertently disrupt or damage work
- Provide an overview of the business and its operations
- Have students observe and speak to employees in a variety of positions and levels as possible to provide an overview of career options
- Reinforce the importance of academic success and good habits: punctuality, consistent attendance, etc.
- Answer questions students may have

After the Industry Tour

- Provide feedback to the school
- Consider additional partnership opportunities: Career Speaker, Job Shadowing, Internships
