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| Career Speakers | Short-term School Site | A business representative gives a prepared presentation to a small group of students to share information about career journeys, education and training requirements, and the skills needed to be successful. |
| Mock Interviews | Short-term School Site | Students practice interviews to learn how to answer questions, improve their verbal and non-verbal communication, and how to become more confident in future interviews. |
| Business/Industry Tours | Short-term Business Site | A business representative gives students/faculty a tour of the facility to share information and highlight a variety of job opportunities. |
| Career Mentoring | Short-term Business Site <i>Volunteer Clearances needed</i> | A business representative meets with a student to share insights and provide guidance about the workplace, work ethics, careers and educational requirements. <i>Minimum of 6 hours.</i> |
| Job Shadowing | Short-term Business Site <i>Volunteer Clearances needed</i> | Students gain exposure to a career by visiting the workplace, investigating a career field and experiencing a typical day on the job. <i>Minimum of 3 hours per experience. Minimum of 3 separate experiences.</i> |
| Educator in the Workforce Visits | Short-term Business Site | Teachers visit innovative employers to build positive relationships and become better equipped with the knowledge, skills and traits students need in order to be successful in the workplace. |
| Internships | Long-term Business Site <i>Volunteer Clearances needed</i> | Students participate in a structured work-based learning opportunity in a particular career area. Students document their activities and growth and a business representative serves as the mentor/supervisor. <i>This is an unpaid career exploration opportunity. Minimum of a 6-week experience and/or 60 total hours.</i> |
| Work-Based Learning Opportunities | Long-Term Business Site <i>Volunteer Clearances needed</i> | Students participate in a structured program related to a career of interest. There is a training agreement with an outlined plan that includes learning objectives and student evaluation requirements. <i>This is a paid career exploration opportunity. Minimum of 1 semester. Required hours per week dependent upon number of credits to be earned.</i> |
