# Regular Board of Education Meeting ELCO High School Library

July 13, 2015

The Regular Board of Education Meeting was called to order by Vice President Carrie Boyer at 6:00 p.m.

The Eastern Lebanon County School Board met in a Regular Session in the ELCO High School Library with Vice President Boyer presiding and leading the Opening Exercises.

#### Roll Call

The Secretary called the roll. The following members were present: Mrs. Boyer, Mrs. Souders; and Messrs. Gardener, Houtz, Kahl, Mark and Moll. Absent from the meeting was Mrs. Walck and Mr. Bernard. #### **Board President Communications**

The Board met in an Executive Session at 5:15 p.m., July 13, 2015, to discuss personnel matters.

## Written Requests to Address the Board

- 1. Dr. Cynthia Flanagan addressed the Board on the topic "The Necessity for Immediate Educational Change" in regards to the trauma sensitive child and the immediate need for our staff to be trained and given resources to help in the learning/teaching process. A video clip was also shown and handouts were also provided to all Board Members with information shared and data collected.
  - Carrie Boyer, presiding President of the meeting, stated the District does not endorse or condone the video shown.
- 2. Dr. Thomas Noone introduced Dr. John Howton, who spoke on a "Professionals Perspective on Education" and gave further information on trauma sensitive children. He expressed the need for staff to be trained and given tools to make a positive impact on these students.

Carrie Boyer, presiding President, Board Members, and Dr. Zuilkoski thanked Dr. Flanagan and Dr. Howton for their presentations. Dr. Zuilkoski responded with additional information on resiliency and the importance of having a trusted adult in these student's lives. The development of establishing trusting relationships between students and teachers is one of ELCO's goals for the 2015-2016 school year. During the year the administrative team will make staff development and training opportunities available to address this issue so that the care and needs of our students are met
