Superintendent's Report

Mrs. Vicente shared the following news:

- Announcement of a program Career Ready Lebanon, which is focused on providing opportunities such as shadowing, mentoring and interning to regional students through local career pathways. A group of students from all six Lebanon County School Districts and the CTC were polled and asked the question, "What is your dream job?" The student's answers were compiled and made into a video created by our own Amy Hicks, Business Education teacher. After viewing the video, Mrs. Davis was asked to share with the Board a demo of the site and give further information of the program. The program's goal is to put businesses and organizations in touch with local educators, who are working to connect the business community to their classroom, school, and students. Results of the program would give every business provider an opportunity to help shape our local workforce and ensure we have more informed students, a more skilled workforce, and a brighter future for Lebanon County.

- Fort Zeller Elementary Mr. Lin
 - o 1st semester ended and the start of the 2nd semester has been good, with focus on academic bench marking.
 - o January 25 PTO sponsored a roller-skating party with 178 in attendance at Mt. Gretna.
- Jackson Elementary Mrs. Hower
 - Star Lab (mobile planetarium) will be brought to Jackson on February 4, with Mr. Wright providing instruction to our students.
 - o Mr. Wright collaborated with teachers using the Cosmos app, funded through the PA Smart grant.
- Intermediate School Mrs. Vicente reported for Dr. Gerhart
 - On January 30, the 3rd grade classes had the opportunity to hear and meet one of the PA State Police K-9 tracker dog units and how the unit serves the public. Dr. Gerhart was able to play a 'unique' part in the demonstration of search and rescue using the K-9 unit.
 - Mr. Wright worked with our students from the Intermediate School at IU13 for the K'NEX Challenge, with the Intermediate School receiving the Best Blueprint Award.
- Middle School Mr. Marks
