



Eastern Lebanon County School District Pandemic Flu Action Plan

Response level will be determined in coordination with local and state health and educational agencies.



LEVEL 1: MONITORING*

- School in session
- Provide preventative education campaign
- Initiate Pandemic Action Plan
- Implement Policies 203, Communicable Diseases and Immunization, and 805, Emergency Evacuation of Schools
- Consider postponing student and staff travel to areas that are a focus of infection, reschedule as possible
- Consider prohibiting groups traveling to ELCO from areas that are a focus of infection



LEVEL 2: LIMITING

- School in session
- Consider postponing events held by outside groups in ELCO buildings, reschedule as possible**
- Consider postponing student and staff travel in areas that are a focus of infection, reschedule as possible
- Consider prohibiting groups traveling from areas that are a focus of infection to ELCO
- Consider suspending volunteer programs as appropriate



LEVEL 3: POSTPONING

- School in session
- Consider postponing all athletic and extracurricular activities, reschedule as possible
- Consider postponing all district-sponsored events, reschedule as possible
- Consider postponing all travel and field trips, reschedule as possible



LEVEL 4: CLOSING

- Consider closing school buildings

*ELCO will monitor infection status daily to determine the appropriate level of response

**Outside groups are Classes 2 and 3 on the ELCO Application for Use of School Facilities

ELCO WILL FOLLOW GUIDELINES FROM THE CDC, PA DEPT. OF HEALTH AND STATE HEALTH CENTER OF LEBANON COUNTY

- Mandatory 14-day quarantine for any staff member and/or student with a confirmed case or living with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19
- Mandatory 14-day quarantine for any staff member or student who has traveled to/from CDC-designated Level 3 and 4 areas
- Suggested 14-day self-quarantine for anyone living with someone who traveled to/from CDC-designated Level 3 and 4 areas and is asymptomatic
