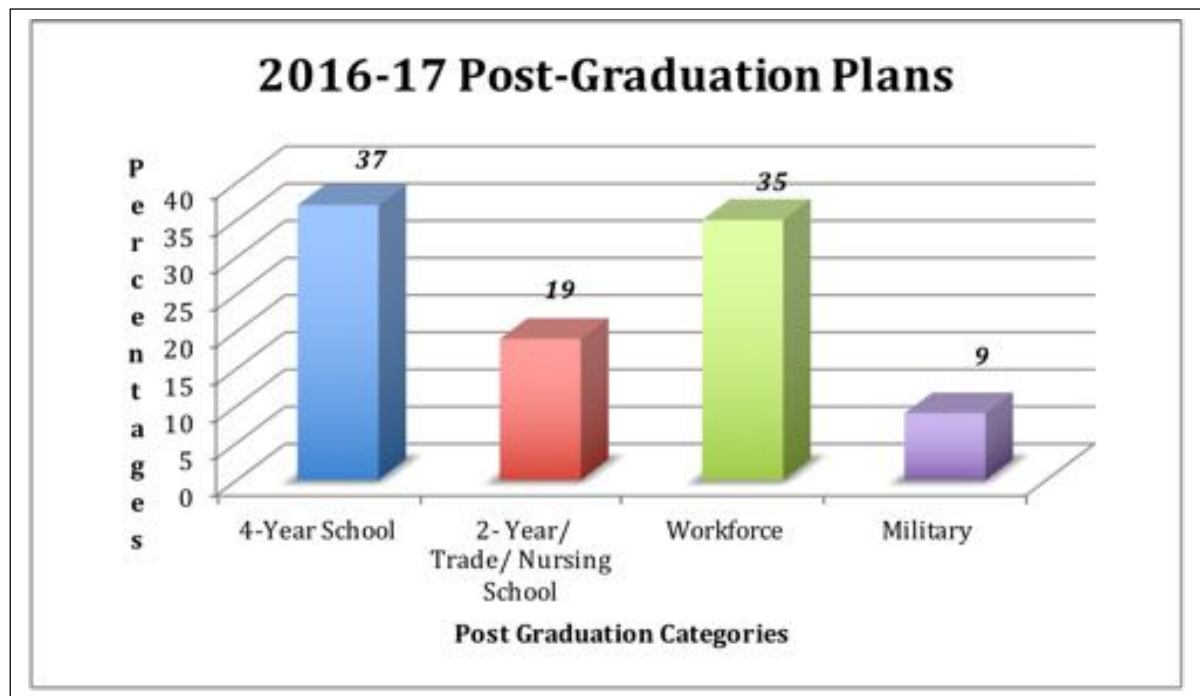

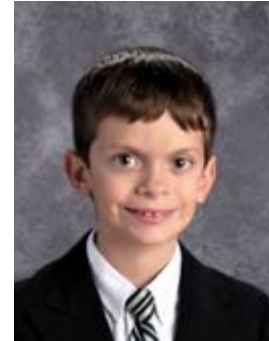

Track & Field

The girls' team finished the season with a 5-3 record and top performers on this year's team were Jalissa Nolt, Alyssa Keath, Alexis Thomas, Kaylynn Keppley, Hannah Williams, Emily Bidelsbach, Abbie Keath, Jordan Rosengrant, and Alicia Yoh. Alexis Thomas qualified for the District Meet and set a school record in the Shot Put.

The "Bob and Louise Trump Junior High Invitational." was held on Saturday, April 8 and was a great success. Special thanks to the track coaches and varsity team members who helped assist with this meet and the Booster Club who also played a big role in this great event.
